Comments: When the Quality Assurance Monitor arrived on site, the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that the educators and the children were all outdoor playing. When inspecting the classroom, the QA Monitor noticed that the attendance records were inside of the classroom. The attendance record must always accompany the group when leaving the building. As soon as the QA Monitor notified an educator, the educator brought the records outside with them. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the monitoring inspection the Quality Assurance Monitor has observed educators coming into the building, leaving the other educators over their ratio. The Quality Assurance Monitor has shared the concerns with the administrator and has given tips on how to respect the ratio while also needing to go indoor. The administrator approached the educators to notify them of their responsibility over ratio. During the remainder of the visit, the educators and the administrator were vigilant and no other incidents occurred in regards to ratio not being respected. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection. During the inspection the QA Monitor was able to observe the children during the outdoor play. Purposefully planned and documented activities were observed during the visit and the children were observed partaking in multiple enriching play experiences.
