Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed empty bags of old snacks and brown paper towel in a cupboard in the bathroom upstairs. The administrator must ensure that the indoor play area is maintained clean. While on site, an administrator cleaned up the cupboard. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: The inspector observed a round rusted metal with 2 holes in the toy bin. The administrator must ensure that the outdoor play area is maintained safe and clean. While on site, an educator disposed of the round metal. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: 5 of 15 verified lunchboxes are not labelled with the child's name. All personal belongings must be labelled with the child's name. While on site, an educator has written the name of the child on their lunchboxes. Deficiency is now compliant
