During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that a new staff member did not have a completed Social Development check on file. The Quality Assurance Monitor brought this to the operator's attention, who explained that the staff member was present that morning for orientation only and that they were still awaiting the completed check from Social Development. However, the Quality Assurance Monitor noted that while gathering ratio information at the beginning of the visit, the staff member in question had been counted in the child-to-staff ratio. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that all staff must have a completed Social Development check on file prior to beginning employment and should not be present on-site until it is received. Shortly afterward, the operator obtained the completed check from Social Development. Deficiency is now compliant

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor was on site to conduct the renewal inspection.

Child-to-staff ratios were maintained throughout the visit.

During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed children engaged in various activities, including outdoor and indoor play, snack time, lunch, and nap time.

It was noted that some educators had not yet completed their required professional learning hours. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the operator that it is their responsibility to ensure all educators complete the mandatory 10 hours of professional learning before the end of their renewal period. This will be verified at the next monitoring inspection.
