Comments: During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that 1 out of 10 child records verified was missing the name, address, and telephone number of the medical practitioner. All child records must include the name, address, and telephone number of the medical practitioner. The operator immediately contacted the parents of the child in question, and the information was added to the file. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the copy of the child's immunization record, or a copy of an exemption, was missing in 1 of the 10 child records verified. Each child record must include a copy of the child's immunization record or a copy of an exemption. The operator immediately contacted the parents of the child in question, and the information was added to the file. Deficiency is now compliant			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on-site to conduct a monitoring inspection.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is present during morning indoor play, lunch, and the transition to nap time.
