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<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to conduct a monitoring inspection.</p> <p>During the visit, the followings were verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Daily activities</li> <li>- washrooms</li> <li>- Daily routine</li> <li>- Indoor play area</li> <li>- Storage space</li> <li>- Personal belongings</li> </ul> <p>The QAM had a discussion with the administrator and certain educators regarding daily programming and documentation practices. One educator shared that she sits with the children to determine their interests and gather their ideas, which she records on a whiteboard. The QAM noted that it would be best to take pictures of the whiteboard or record the information on a separate page to ensure proper documentation, as the content on a whiteboard is erased with time.</p> <p>During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor did not observe children going outside. A discussion was held with the administrator regarding the importance of ensuring daily outdoor time. The administrator informed the QAM that during school days, it is uncommon for the children to visit the assigned municipal playground. Several reasons were provided and discussed. The administrator also explained that most children already spend time outdoors after school, either while walking to the facility or while waiting outside for pick-up at school. Additionally, the administrator stated that the children spend significant amounts of time outdoors when school is closed and throughout the summer months. The operator may submit a detailed exemption request to the Department, and it will be evaluated accordingly.</p>
