Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed in 1 of the verified children's files that two emergency contacts have the same phone number. The inspector had a discussion with the administrator about the importance of having two different phone number for each emergency contact. The operator must ensure that all children's file are complete with all required information as per prescribed in the regulation.			
27 An operator of a licensed facility shall obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian of a child receiving services at the licensed facility before doing any of the following: (g) transporting or providing for the transportation of the child.	27(g)	Nov 09, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that in 2 out of 12 audited children's files the consent for transporting the child from school to the facility while using the facility's transportation is missing. The inspector had a discussion with the administrator that all children receiving transportation from school to the facility need to have consent from the parents/guardians.			
30(1) A full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre shall have an indoor play area of at least 3.25 m <sup>2</sup> for each child receiving services at the centre.	30(1)	Oct 26, 2023	Oct 26, 2023
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed 30 school age children in one classroom. The maximum room capacity permitted is 19 children. During the inspection, the children returned to their respective classrooms. The operator must ensure that the educators respect the capacity of the classrooms at all times. Deficiency is now compliant			
30(3) An operator shall maintain the indoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	30(3)	Nov 10, 2023	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed a hole in the wall in the washroom, leaving drywall exposed. The operator must ensure that the hole in the wall is repaired in order to ensure the indoor play is maintained clean and safe.

<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed a Vim bottle unlocked under the sink cabinet. During the inspection, the inspector advised an educator of the cleaning product found. The educator immediately placed the Vim bottle in a locked storage room. Deficiency is now compliant</p>			
<p>48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.</p>	48(2)	Oct 31, 2023	
<p>Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed 1 lunch box not labelled with the child's name. The operator must ensure that each lunch box is labelled with the child's name. The inspector also observed that 5 of the verified water bottles are not labelled with the name of the child. In order to prevent and control transmissible diseases, the operator must ensure that each water bottle is labelled with the child's name.</p>			
<p>50(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall maintain a chronologically filed daily incident log relating to the health, security and well-being of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.</p>	50(1)	Nov 03, 2023	
<p>Comments: During the inspection renewal, the inspector observed that the type of care provided is not indicated on the incident log. The operator must ensure that all required information is recorded on the logs, including, child's name, date, time, injury and care provided, description of circumstances and parent's signature. The inspector also observed one of the children's files contained other children's incident logs. All information, including the incident logs, must remain confidential. The operator must ensure that the incident logs are in the appropriate child's file.</p>			

<p><b>General Comments</b></p>
<p>During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed the children arriving from school to the facility. Children were participating in a guided activity while listening to Halloween music. Inspector also observed the snacks provided and both indoor and outdoor play. A discussion occurred with a staff member to ensure that there is adequate supervision outside in the outdoor play area, where a large piece of maintenance equipment is stored.</p> <p>The ratio was respected during the inspection.</p>
