Comments: The inspector observed in 1 out of 10 children files verified that 1 emergency contact lived one hour away from the facility. The administrator must ensure that the emergency contact must be able to respond within one hour if parents/guardians cannot be reached.

An educator stated that the bathroom is inaccessible to children because it is not working. 4 bathrooms are necessary for the numbers of children attending the facility. The administrator must ensure that all bathrooms are in working order.

The inspector observed one group playing a game for a wild turkey with dices.

The inspector did not observe the outdoor play area of the facility. The outdoor play area will be conducted at a later time by a licensing staff.
