Comments: The inspector observed in 1 out of 10 children files verified that 1 emergency contact lived one hour away from the facility. The administrator must ensure that the emergency contact must be able to respond within one hour if parents/guardians cannot be reached.			
38(1) The children receiving services at a licensed facility shall have access to washrooms that include the following: (a) if one to nine preschool children or school-age children are receiving the services, one toilet and one sink; (b) if ten to 24 preschool children or school-age children are receiving the services, two toilets and two sinks; (c) if 25 to 49 preschool children or school-age children are receiving the services, three toilets and three sinks; and (d) if 50 or more preschool children or school-age children are receiving the services, four toilets and four sinks.	38(1)	Oct 17, 2025	
Comments: The inspector observed that one bathroom door is locked. An educator stated that the bathroom is inaccessible to children because it is not working. 4 bathrooms are necessary for the numbers of children attending the facility. The administrator must ensure that all bathrooms are in working order.			

General Comments
The inspector observed children arriving from school to the facility. Once arrival, children were asked to go wash their hands before going into their respective room. The inspector observed one group playing a game for a wild turkey with dices. The inspector did not observe the outdoor play area of the facility. The outdoor play area will be conducted at a later time by a licensing staff. The ratio is respected during the inspection.
