### General Comments

The center appears to be very clean. I signed in at the entranceway where there is a visitors log. COVID protocols are being followed. Each room has their own routine, and some of the infants were already sleeping while others had free play before going to sleep. The two year olds played before having lunch, and then they were transitioning to nap time. The three year olds played, had lunch, and then were napping or doing quiet activities. The four year olds were having free play after lunch. There is documentation of children's learning on the walls of the classrooms and in the hallways. Children's work is also displayed. There was one room that had some children's work up, and also I suggested more children's work and documentation be displayed.

Program planning is taking place in each room. The educators program weekly using an app which assists in helping to link the planning back to the curriculum. It also allows for the planning of invitations and table top activities, as well as outdoor play and science experiments. There are a number of ideas and activities planned for each room and I noticed that there were materials ready for activities in the classrooms. We brainstormed ways to make transitions run more smoothly into nap time in one room. They have tried many things, and the next thing to try would be to focus on darkening the room a little more.

The classrooms have a variety of materials for the children to play with and each classroom is set up into play centers. Positive child guidance is being used in each of the rooms. Educators were engaged in activities with the children and they appeared to be comfortable in the space. Attendance sheets are kept up to date and reasons for absence are being used. Incident reports and logs are being filled out. The program appeared to be going well during the visit.
