The infants were still arriving when licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility. Once all of the infants arrived for the day, the children and the educators went outdoors to play.					
The two year old class was playing outside when licensing staff was observing the class. The children were engaged in a variety of outdoor play activities during the monitoring inspection visit.					
Educators, in all classrooms, were observed engaging with the children throughout the inspection visit. Licensing staff heard lots of positive child guidance techniques used along with encouragement and redirection.					
Licensing staff observed smooth transitions from outside to inside. All classrooms had multiple learning centres for the children to engage with.					

The outdoor environment had a lot of natural materials for the children to engage with.

The four/five year old classroom had a field trip to Connell Park on the day of the monitoring inspection visit. Licensing staff went to Connell Park to observe this class. When licensing staff arrived at the local community park, the children were just finishing up their lunches. The children and educators had trouble with the hornets while at the park; however, the educators moved the children away from the pergola where most of the hornets were seen. The children relayed to licensing staff that they had a great time at the park this morning.

Licensing staff noted that the sand surrounding the stationary equipment needs to be tilled up as the sand has packed down with the rain that we received this week. Regular tilling or raking is required in order for the protective surfacing to remain a fall safe zone.
