Once children finished snack this morning, they gathered on the carpet to play with fidget toys and wait for everyone to be done. Once everyone was on the carpet, one educator led the group in some discussion and songs including sign language. The children signed several animals and joined in singing you are my sunshine and the alphabet song with voice and signs. While a story was read, the educators set up activity centres throughout the room and invited children to choose which one they would like. Evidence of documentation was posted in each of the rooms with a poster with children's summer plans including photos and quotes from the children, a summer flower art project, and various art pieces created by the children throughout the spaces. One of the educators in the back preschool gave children a choice between two books for read aloud. Both educators encouraged discussion once the books were read and built on previous books and experiences. One of the educators is expecting a baby and she supplied some information about the baby's size which allowed the children to discuss further elements including making predictions of hair and eye color. The children were offered a dance party while waiting for a shared activity with school age children and the children were laughing and dancing around to the floor is lava song and then getting off the floor at the dance instructions. Several school age children visited each room today "teaching" the younger children how to make playdough. The supplies and instructions were presented by the school-age children and a parent and children encouraged to be involved in the process of creation. Children also got to decide on the color and then lots of rolling and playing after created. The educators sat at the table with the children for playing with the playdough talking about colors, mixing, and shapes that can be made.
