<p>Comments: While observing the children play in the outdoor environments, it was noted that the play materials were not varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Please add additional play materials for all children present at the licensed facility.</p>			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Jun 26, 2024	
<p>Comments: While conducting the license renewal inspection, licensing staff noted that the kitchen door was open multiple times during the inspection and toxics (cleaning supplies) are not secured by a lock and key.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Please ensure the toxics are locked with a lock and key to ensure the safety of the children.</p>

<p>Comments: While conducting observations in the kitchen area, a bottle of Tylenol and Benadryl were being stored on the top of a filing cabinet and not in a locked box or cabinet. Please ensure all medications are locked away in order to maintain the safety of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.</p> <p>When I brought this to the attention of the Director at the facility, she moved the medications to the locked box in the fridge.</p>			

General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility today to conduct the license renewal inspection.

When licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility, all of the children were playing outside to beat the heat this afternoon.

All educators were practicing positive child guidance and redirection.

All educators were very engaged with the children during indoor and outdoor play.

Licensing staff observed multiple pieces of evidence of the children's learning posted on the walls of the facility.

When licensing staff noted a bottle of Tylenol and Benadryl being stored on a filing cabinet in the kitchen (unlocked) and brought this to the attention of the Acting Director, the Acting Director moved the medication to the locked box in the fridge.
