General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility while children were still arriving for the day.

The children were observed engaging in free play activities before eating washing up and going outdoors to play. Licensing staff observed documentary evidence of the children's learning posted on the walls in each classroom. In two of the classrooms licensing staff observed laminated books consisting of pictures of the children's families for the children to look at during the day while receiving care at the licensed facility. In most of the classrooms there were multiple distinct learning centres for the children to play.

Child to staff ratios were within regulation as per the Early Childhood Services Act.

Licensing staff observed the educator's using redirection with the children when exhibiting challenging
