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General Comments
Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the annual License Renewal Inspection. Upon arrival, children in the three-to-four-year-old classroom were engaged in free play. The learning environment was organized into distinct play areas that supported a variety of learning experiences, including a book/cozy centre, dramatic play centre, gross motor activity centre, and mark-making/craft centre. Children in the two-year-old classroom were also participating in free play activities. Evidence of learning was displayed throughout the classroom, allowing children to revisit and reflect on previous learning experiences. Educators were observed actively engaging with children at their level and participating in play-based learning experiences. Evidence of learning was displayed in each classroom, supporting children's ongoing learning and reflection. The outdoor learning environments contained play materials for children to explore and use; however, it is recommended that a greater variety of play materials be provided to enhance play opportunities and support diverse interests. Recommendations -Remove all broken play materials from the indoor and outdoor play environments. -Ensure stagnant water is drained from the recycled tires located on the playground. -Ensure all educators use positive child guidance strategies when redirecting children who are displaying challenging or undesired behaviours. Licensing staff will provide a PowerPoint presentation developed from the Operator Manual for Full-Time and Part-Time Early Learning and Childcare Centres for review and reference. Based on observations made during the inspection, licensing staff recommend the facility for license renewal.
