Deficiency is now compliant

Inspector arrives on site for the follow up inspection. 2 children have life threatening allergies that require Epipens. Both Epipen's are on site stored in an easily accessible location for educators and also out of reach of the children. These are listed on the allergie posting placed in a visible and prominent location. Ratio is respected during the follow up inspection.
