The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site this morning to conduct a monitoring inspection.
The following elements were verified:

It was observed that the name and telephone number of the Quality Assurance Monitor and Inspector were not current. The Quality Assurance Monitor recommended updating the information and will verify this during the next visit.
The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the director regarding designation requirements. The director confirmed that the Quality Improvement Plan is current and that all eligible educators are actively completing their required 10 hours of professional learning per renewal year.
During the Monitoring Inspection, independent play, gym activities, transitions to outdoor play, and children playing outdoors were observed.
