The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site this afternoon to conduct a follow-up inspection.

During the follow-up visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that new educators were on-site. Only one of the two educators had their staff file available; the second file was locked in a filing cabinet, and the key was not accessible during the inspection. The educator in question was sent home until the administrator could provide the missing documentation by email. The administrator submitted the file the following day, and the Quality Assurance Monitor will verify the file during her next visit.

During the visit, it was observed that children were transitioning to and from the splash pad, engaging in free play, and preparing to go outside.

The ratio is respected throughout the visit.
