Comments: The inspector reviewed 13 children's files and observed that 2 of them are missing the children's Medicare numbers. Each child's file must contain the child's name, address, date of birth, and Medicare number.			

General Comments
The inspector is on-site to conduct the renewal inspection. During the inspection, the inspector observed morning free play, snack time, transitions to outdoor play, outdoor activities, and water play. The inspector observed a small kiddie pool containing a minimal amount of water being used as a sensory table under direct supervision. A discussion is held with the administrator to ensure that the water is emptied after each use and that children using the sensory table are continuously supervised to ensure their safety. A discussion is also held with the administrator regarding employee files, ensuring that all files must be complete and contain all required certificates and documentation, with no missing information. The inspector observed the lunch period and in one classroom, children are engaged in making bird feeders, while another classroom participated in a nature walk. Positive child guidance is observed such as speaking softly and respectful to the children. The ratio is respected throughout the inspection.
