Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that diaper changing procedures were placed in all diaper changing areas. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that all lunch boxes were labelled with the child's name. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: The inspector observed that infant bottles stored in the refrigerator had covers. Deficiency is now compliant
