<p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to conduct the renewal inspection for the inspector.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is present during outdoor play, lunch, nap, indoor play and snack time.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the staff members reading books to the children. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed the staff members using soothing nursery rhymes to create a calm and comforting atmosphere, helping children to fall asleep for their nap.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor observed several small ants in the sandbox located in the infant outdoor play area. The observation was discussed with the operator. The Quality Assurance Monitor recommends that the sandbox be cleaned before being used by the children.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the operator and the administrator regarding the period of rest that must not exceed two consecutive hours unless there is a written request from a child's parent or guardian to extend the length of time.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor also had a discussion with the operator regarding the professional learning hours that certain staff members must complete by August 31, 2025. The operator is responsible for ensuring that all eligible staff members have completed 10 hours of professional learning during the renewal year.</p> <p>The ratio is respected during the visit.</p>
