Quality Assurance Monitor discussed the following with the Operator:

The school age program is purposely planned and documented through photos, webs, artifacts, operator reflections and social media. During the Pandemic the Operator has made efforts to ensure parents remain informed about their children and what is happening during their time at the facility.

Numerous opportunities are provided for children to explore their interests. The environment is purposely planned in response to the interests of the children through materials, activities indoors and outdoors, relationships and conversations.

Children are outdoors daily. Natural materials have been added to the play area to provide children with a number of new experiences.

Children are provided opportunities to explore their interests in groups and individually.

Numerous opportunities to explore various forms of literacy are provided within the environment, i.e. reading materials, numeracy, book making, using language to express ideas and share interests, art work, indoors and outdoors through various mediums including chalk, paint, paper and music.

Loose parts, invitations and a variety of materials and resources are accessible to children throughout the day to express their creativity and interests.

Arts and sciences are explored based on child and educator interests. Operator provides materials, time and space for children to explore the natural environment through experimentation, sharing of knowledge and their questions. Opportunities for further exploration, through new questions and additional materials are provided. Operator introduces local interests with opportunities for further exploration and to extend learning.
