Quality Assurance Monitor observed children eating snack, finishing snack, playing trucks, kitchen, backpacks, blocks, and a group sand activity. Positive child guidance was observed during the sand activity as children were struggling with sharing. Educator/Operator continued to calmly discus ways that the sand can be shared, and how to take turns, and adding in other items to redirect.

Quality Assurance Monitor notes that staff member without a check from Social Development may not be onsite until the check has been completed.

Quality Assurance Monitor and Operator discussed the importance of having an organized filing system, and QAM recommends a full review and reorganization of the files so that they are easy to access.
