The operator share that all the 10 hours of professional learning had been completed; however, the certificate or the reflection sheet is missing. The operator must have documentation showing completion of 10 hours of professional learning, either in certificates or reflection sheets.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the fire extinguisher is not on site. The operator shared that the fire extinguisher is currently being inspected at the Fire Safety. The fire extinguisher must be available on site.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Aug 08, 2025	Aug 01, 2025
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed water bottles that were not labelled with the name of the child. Personal belongings must be labelled with the name of the child. The operator immediately labelled the water bottles with the name of the child. Deficiency is now compliant
