General Comments

Children and Educators were engaged in outdoor play during today's renewal inspection. An abundance of loose parts are available for children to use as they explore the wooded area. "Bouncy tree" was observed to be a favourite activity with children exploring risk, negotiating and communicating as they worked together and bounced on the tree. Other children were playing with balls, and sharing time together in the forest.

The indoor environment is organized to be inviting with a variety of materials for the children to choose from. Documentation posted throughout the environment demonstrates educators commitment to highlighting children's abilities, strengths and learning. A recent exploration of the parts of a plant and children's representations using loose parts was great! They were all unique in the way children used the materials available to them to create and label the parts of a plant.
