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<p>General Comments</p> <p>A renewal inspection occurred in the afternoon on this license.</p> <p>Upon arrival at the childcare facility, Inspector reviewed all staff files and conducted a random review of the children's files. These were verified complete and with all required information.</p> <p>The children arrived at the school-age program and proceeded to their outdoor classrooms. The children were observed outside during the entire renewal inspection.</p> <p>The children were observed by the Inspector creating fairy homes with tree circles, popsicle sticks, pompoms, glue, markers, string, and pieces of felt and cloth. The children informed the Inspector that they were hoping to see fairies using their homes once they decided where to put them in the outdoor classrooms.</p> <p>Some children were observed engaged at the picnic table in make-believe play with Lego figures with their peers. Other children were observed digging in the dirt and mixing it with water and leaves to create "lunch." A game of mini sticks was occurring with a few of the children during their time outside.</p> <p>A wooden stand has been added to the outdoor classroom where children can hang their jackets and backpacks, always keeping them off the ground.</p> <p>The children and an educator were observed exploring several types of mushrooms that the children had discovered in the wooded area.</p> <p>In the indoor learning environment, the children's learning was observed documented and displayed in the entry way. Learning stories and pictures of the children discovering how to navigate using a compass, creating cooperative sports teams, and exploring the growing process of seeds were posted.</p> <p>In the outdoor learning environment, it was observed that the leaves are beginning to form on the trees. Once this process is complete, the area will be fully shaded for the children.</p>

General Comments

Educators were observed, during the inspection, positioning themselves throughout and around the outdoor learning environment so that the children were always within their site even during indirect supervision.

Educators were observed helping children problem solve when disputes arrived, speaking kindly and appropriately to the children and guiding them to work on solutions together.

Facility is recommended for license renewal.
