<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring visit performed. Two compliances to address - 2 toilet paper holders need replaced, diaper change procedure is missing in one of the change rooms and storage of potty seats must be off the floor. Window cleaner needs to be kept locked that I observed in one of the classrooms. The educator immediately placed it in a locked cupboard. thank you Upon arrival babies were waking up from nap and enjoying some quiet wake up activities. The 2's were involved in free choice or activities and the 3/4 group were involved in a science activity which will be completed on Friday. Operator is following Covid Protocols. The province has now moved to Level 1. Staff are masking and children in common areas. Administrative records were reviewed and attendance, fire drills and outdoor check list was verified. Child guidance observed was appropriated and children were comforted when needed. I would suggest playing soft background children's music and using softer tone in your voices when speaking to the children. It is also recommended providing plenty of transition time between activities. Children need notice before finishing and moving onto another activity. Staff were also getting the children ready to go for outdoor play.</p>
