Monitoring inspection performed. Please post my new telephone number - 506-429-2028 Upon arrival the 2,3 and 4's and educators were in their respective classrooms. The 2/3's were creating heart shape Sun catchers and sticking different colored paper on them. The educator made the suncatchers using mac tac so this made it easier for this young group to stick on the pieces of paper allowing them to create their own design. Children were observed dancing to child music, playing with dollies and Mr. Potato head. Children love the Baby shark song and loved listening to the Dinky donkey story book. The babies were observed coming						

back after a morning walk in their stroller and wagon. The babies love playing with the balls as they practiced rolling them back and forth. It is a beautiful morning to be outdoors, though licensing staff didnot observe any evidence that the preschool outdoor play area had been used by children this AM. The educators in the 3/4 class have set up stations in their room today, and children had a choice of activities - decorating bags for valentine cards with sticky hearts, gems and other small designs, playing in the construction zone and building with lego etc.

Educators were observed using appropriate child guidance and they were heard saying "that is so nice, you are a good helper, you are strong, wow. Educators were observed engaged with children at the child's eye level and would kneel down when speaking to children. It is important to remember to use gentle reminders and prepare children for transitions rather than saying 'I am not asking you again'.

Administrative records were reviewed - , new staff info, attendance is tracked for both staff and children, incident reports are being documented and signed by parents so they are made aware, infant toddler records are documented - (as a kind reminder remember to sign the record at the end of the day too), fire drills are practiced and recorded monthly also.

After review of attendance records, licensing staff verified that ratio is being maintained during lunches. That is, Page 1 of 2 **General Comments**

enough staff remain in the building to ensure ratios are maintained during this time of the day. Staff are also signing out when/if they leave the building.

A few staff had some questions around illness and when children should go home. Please review the "Guidelines for the Prevention and Control of Communicable Diseases in ELC facilities Appendix 39 page 217-250 in the Operator handbook with all staff to ensure everyone understands when children (including staff) should be leaving the facility and when Illness notices should be posted. Parents also have a responsibility to advise reasons for children's absence when it is illness related.
