Comments: Refer to general comments as this is not always being signed off so parents are made aware. A recommendation has been made for recording incidents to make assessable to ELC licensing staff.							

Monitoring visit performed.

Administrative records were reviewed during the inspection - all attendance of staff and children, infant toddler records, fire drill record, and the outdoor maintenance check list.

Licensing staff learned that incidents are being recorded in individual notebooks, however they are missing important information and they are not always being signed off so parents are made aware.

It is recommended the Operator create one based on section 6.6.1 from the Operator manual. The incident log must show the following information - child's name, date, time, injury or behavior that occurred and the care that was provided, what happened and parent's signature. To make it easier for ELC staff to review and access this information, the logs can be stored in a binder in the office and filed in chronological order once signed by the parent. To protect confidentiality, parents should not see the records of other children in the binder. Non reportable and reportable incidents must be signed off on the day of the incident. Continue to use Appendix 15 to document reportable incidents which should be stored in the child file.

Licensing staff observed children napping, in outdoor play, painting plant pots to give to Moms on Mother's Day, babies are learning their colors and have made a Mother's Day craft, and other children are learning different songs. This is evident as the songs are posted in the classroom. Licensing staff suggest posting the songs at children's eye level and other programming materials.
