Comments: Deficiency is now compliant. Licensing inspector observed that no documentation had been completed today on the infant daily info sheet. As advised these forms must be documented after diaper changes, eating snack lunches and times for napping etc. This was corrected during the inspection.

Comments: Documentation of children's learning can come in many forms in order to make children's learning visible. That is, through posting photos, group learning stories/activities, songs children love to sing, letters/new words, projects children are interested in etc. (like in the 3/4 year group on weather and bugs). Make children's learning visible and bring materials, books, and other loose parts into the classroom and set up stations to invite children into play opportunities where they can explore and learn about their passions and interests indoors and outside. Licensing staff did observe program calendars in the classrooms, but educators need to work on documentation also. The licensing inspector recommends the Administrator contact the District team for support and guidance.

This was discussed with the educator and the educator ceased doing this going forward.						

General Comments

Administrative records were reviewed during the inspection visit. Fire Drills are practiced and recorded monthly, incident reports are being recorded and signed by the parent so they are aware, and these reports are stored in a binder, staff records were reviewed, staff PL hours on track, and outdoor checklist is being documented. Licensing staff made an observation and kind reminder that one staff needs to register for First Aid as it will expire the end of April.

To promote independence for toddlers 15 months and older, licensing staff would recommend the table stored in the infant/toddler room is used for children to sit and eat snacks and lunches. This will also aid in transitioning children to the 2 year old room.

All children were observed going down for a nap after lunch, however the 3- and 4-year-olds who do not nap are invited to move from the mat to other activities after 30 minutes. Children were observed waking up during the visit also.

Educators were observed assisting children with eating, sitting with children while they ate lunch, and sitting with children and rubbing their backs softly during naptime.

All children were involved in outdoor play this AM.

Children in the 3/4/5-year-old room are interested in the weather and bugs, however licensing staff did not observe any programming, books, or other materials to support their current interests. Art work was observed in all the classrooms. The administrator that staff do record children's learning and it is taken down and sent home. I indicated in the above comment that children's learning must be visible in the classroom. Read above comment.
