<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring inspection completed today.</p> <p>Materials are displayed at the children's level, making them easily accessible and independently accessed. Invitations set up in interest centres and on tables inspire children to explore and provide a variety of choice for the children.</p> <p>Some documentation and photos posted in rooms. As discussed, Class Dojo is an effective way to document learning for families however, evidence of children's current learning should be posted throughout the indoor environments as well. Opportunities for children to see themselves and past learning in the environment values their process, creates a sense of belonging and provides opportunities to revisit past experiences.</p>
