Children and educators were observed during indoor play, transitions, and outdoor play.

The indoor environments are inviting and through documentation and materials, reflect the children who spend time playing and learning there. The rooms are set up with interest areas, and invitations that spark children's curiosity and inspire exploration and engagement.

During preparation for outdoor play educators were observed to encourage and support children to dress on their own and helping them when asked.

In the outdoor environments, educators were observed engaged in play with children. Asking, questions, responding to children's inquiries, encouraging their imaginative play and using positive child guidance techniques when needed.

Administrative records were reviewed. Attendance forms were completed for children on arrival and departure, and each group took their attendance when they went for outdoor play. New staff files were reviewed.
