<p>Comments: Inspector observed in Room 1A that the Daily Information Sheets for children under 2 years of age were not filled out completely on April 1, 2026, when the children were in attendance. All required information on these mandatory sheets must be filled in daily and signed by educator/staff once completed. Discussed with COO during inspection.</p>

<p>Comments: Room 1A--Inspector observed that the reason the child(ren) were absent was not recorded on the mandatory attendance record dated April 1, 2026. Reason why child is absent must be recorded on the attendance records. If unsure, Administrator to contact parent to find out reason for being absent.</p> <p>Room 1A--Inspector observed that on March 31, 2026, and April 1, 2026, children were not signed out on the mandatory attendance records. Children must be signed in and out on their room's attendance records each day.</p> <p>Room 4A--Inspector observed that children were not signed out on the mandatory attendance records at the end of the day when the children combine in one room. Children's names were observed on the attendance records on the closing room. Children must be signed in and out on their room's attendance records each day.</p>

<p>Comments: Room 1B--Inspector observed that two incident logs dated for March 30, 2026, were not signed by the parent/guardian when they picked up their child(ren) at the end of the day.</p>			

General Comments

A renewal inspection occurred on this license over two days, April 2, 2026, and April 7, 2026.

Inspector observed the children during transitions, morning snack, outside play in the outdoor classrooms, lunch, nap/quiet time and inside play.

In the four infant rooms the children's learning is documented and displayed on the walls. Inspector observed that the children have been exploring music and musical instruments, mark making, exploration in the tuff tray, exploring their senses, outside play in the snow, playing with playdough, blocks, and loose parts. Educators in these rooms were observed down at the level of the children in the learning, play, and exploration. Sitting with them during snack and lunch and singing with the children.

In the three preschool rooms, Inspector observed that the children have been exploring animal tracks in the snow, making animal tracks, painting in the snow, exploring the outside classrooms, and mark making. The children in the three preschool rooms spent most of their time during the inspections in their outside classroom, exploring nature and the surroundings and interacting with their peers.

Educators were observed speaking kindly and appropriately to the children, down at their level in their learning and play. Positive guidance techniques were observed when the educators were interacting with the children.
