<p>General Comments</p> <p>A follow up inspection occurred on this license during the morning.</p> <p>The children were observed during morning snacks and preparing and going outside in the rain to explore the puddles and the outside environments with their educators. Samples of the children's open-ended art activities are displayed throughout each of the early learning environments.</p> <p>Inspector observed that in Infant Room 1A, the children have been exploring sensory activities. Learning stories</p>

and documentation were observed displayed on the walls of the children engaged with oats and chickpeas, scooping and playing with wooden cars. The children have also been exploring sensory with dry pasta, butterflies and flowers; feeling the textures and observing what was given to them.

Infant Room 1B, documentation was observed on the walls of the children planting seeds, exploring the sensory tray, and investigating mud puddles in the outside environment.

Infant Room 2A, documentation on the walls supports the children's current interests of "Wheels on the Bus". Pictures of the children exploring cars and black paint and creating tracks on paper was observed. The children are learning how to walk together as a group, and they have been exploring mark making with paper and markers.

Infant Room 2B, the children have been exploring bugs and nature. Current documentation depicts the children exploring apple trees in the outside environment looking for bugs. Pictures of the children creating caterpillars using creative art materials such as pipe cleaners, pasta and pompoms was observed.

In Room 3, the children have been learning about seeds, what grows from seeds and the difference between seeds used for planting and seeds used to feed livestock. Educators indicated that the children had planted carrots and corn.

Room 4A, the children have a current interest of "food". Educators were observed preparing to make cookies with the children in this group during the inspection. Pictures and learning stories of the children engaged in the mud kitchen, scooping, and pounding seeds and lentils was observed.

Room 4B, documentation was observed on the walls of the children growing seeds, painting their seed pots, painting outside and outside play in the outdoor classrooms.

Educators in the seven rooms on this license were all observed, by the Inspector, tending to the needs of the children, comforting them, assisting in dressing and feeding, diaper changing and potty training, down at their level in their play and learning and using positive child guidance techniques when speaking and interacting with the children in their care.

All orders for compliance were completed, and the facility is recommended for license renewal.
