General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on July 15, 2025.

Children were observed during snack time and outdoor free play.

Educators shared that the children are currently very interested in painting on rocks with chalk in the outdoor play area, being physically active outdoors, eating outside, and digging for worms. Inside the classroom, the children have collaboratively created a family tree, demonstrating strong connections to their families and each other. Outdoors, educators were observed actively engaging with children, supporting their exploration and play.

The center maintains consistent safety and operational standards. Monthly emergency evacuations are completed and visibly posted. A clearly visible and prominent area is used to post the license, current inspection report, monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. The daily routine and evacuation procedures are posted in accessible and prominent locations.

Books that reflect the children's current interests have been thoughtfully selected and made available. The learning environment includes well-defined learning and play areas, and several pieces of children's artwork are proudly displayed throughout the facility, showcasing their creativity and learning.

Cleanliness and safety are evident throughout the facility. Indoor traffic areas and outdoor walkways are kept clean and free of clutter. Toxic products such as chemical cleaners are securely stored and inaccessible to children. Drinking water is provided throughout the day, and allergy information for any children with known allergies is visibly posted for staff awareness.

Educators are intentional in extending curriculum opportunities outdoors and make ongoing efforts to bring elements of the natural world into the classroom. Curriculum webs have been completed with the children and thoughtfully expanded upon by educators, highlighting a commitment to responsive and emergent curriculum practices.
