<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>A renewal inspection occurred on April 14, 2026.</p> <p>The Inspector observed that the children who attend the preschool portion of this license were spending the entire day outside in their outside classroom. Children who attend the school-age program on this license were also observed by the inspector in their outside learning environment.</p> <p>In the indoor preschool environment, inspector observed that the children's learning was documented and displayed throughout the room. Children have been exploring science, conducting experiments by making volcanoes, breaking ice, mixing baking soda and water. They have been learning about animal habitats, what animals are predators and what animals are prey. Documentation also depicts the children exploring loose parts (dried pasta) and creating alphabet art with dried pasta and glue.</p> <p>The children have also been exploring the properties of sinking and floating, and the Inspector observed a chart with the children's predictions of objects.</p> <p>The children have also been exploring the author, Julia Donaldson. The children's art and mark making on the walls shows samples of the children's favorite characters and title of their favorite books by this author.</p> <p>In the outside preschool learning environment, the Inspector observed the children were playing in the mud, learning about planets; and drawing and creating them, building with magnet tiles, climbing trees, pretending the tree stumps were instruments and singing, and reading books with their peers.</p> <p>In the outside school-age environment, children were observed drawing, playing checkers, reading, and swinging in the hammocks and socializing with their peers.</p> <p>Educators in the groups were observed positioning themselves in the outdoor classrooms, so they have clear site of the children in their care at all times. Educators were also observed communing necessary information to each other via walkie talkies.</p>

Educators were observed using positive child guidance techniques when interacting with the children in their care. Down at their level in their conversations and learning.
