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General Comments

Upon licensing staff arrival for the renewal inspection, children were engaged in three different tabletop activities. One station involved catching plastic fish in water using fishing rods, another was a dramatic play area where children prepared different meals using a variety of stuffed food items, and a third station offered magnetic building blocks. Children were able to move freely between the activity stations. The educator introduced a new stuffed giraffe to the group and engaged the children in a discussion about giraffes, including why they have long necks. The group then transitioned to mat time, where the educator wrote a child's name from the group on a chalkboard and invited the children to guess whose name it was. Once identified, the child came forward and wrote their own name beside it. During this time, another educator was with the younger children playing with musical instruments. Music was then played, and the children danced together with the educators.

Due to heavy rainfall, the group remained indoors for outdoor play time. Children continued to engage in free play with a variety of materials, including blocks, toy cars, building blocks, and drawing materials. Educators remained actively engaged with the children and supervised the group throughout the inspection. The educator then told the group that in 10 minutes they had to clean up and have lunch. The group cleaned up together while the educator gave words of encouragements.

The educator then guided the children to wash their hands before sitting down for lunch. The tables were washed as well. Children grabbed their lunch boxes and sat down at the tables. Cots were set up for children who napped after lunch, with their own blankets from home.

Throughout the inspection, only positive child guidance was observed. There is a "learning centre" board where the solar system is displayed, and children are learning and naming each planet. Evidence of learning stories are documented in individual child binders. The staff and child files are in compliance. Monthly fire drills are completed.

Licensing staff recommends the program for renewal.
