<p>General Comments</p> <p>During my unplanned morning visit, I observed that the required staff to child ratios were respected for all age groups present. In addition, younger children were not mixed with other age groups. The following elements were noted during my visit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Designation: The required professional development hours have been completed for the educators concerned. - Verification of a new employee's file and updates to personnel information were completed. - Administrative files: The required records are maintained on site. - Parent access: Parents of the children in attendance may access the daycare at any time. - Rest areas: The daycare provides a designated rest area for younger children. Older children sleep on waterproof, washable mats with a thickness of 5 cm. - Safety measures: No trampoline is accessible. Access to the kitchen is prohibited to children unless they are supervised. The premises are smoke free, and a first aid kit is available. Hot beverages are kept in a spill proof container and placed out of reach of infants and children aged 2 years. - Nutrition: Potable water is always available. Food brought from home are labeled with the child's name. Menus, based on a monthly cycle, are provided to parents, and any changes are communicated at least three days in advance. Food is adapted to children's specific needs, including intolerances or allergies, which are visibly posted on the refrigerator. Bottles are clearly labeled. Infants are never fed a bottle while lying down and are continuously supervised while eating or drinking. <p>Observation of the arrival of several preschool children, along with snacks provided by parents. All children went outside during my visit. Younger children were separated from the older groups during outdoor play.</p>
