Children's blankets used for naptime were all stored together in a cabinet at time of visit. Educator created labelled bags to store each individual child's blankets before end of inspection.

A reminder that by storing children blankets separately, it helps prevent the spread of communicable diseases, lice, skin infections, etc.

General Comments

When I arrived for today's monitoring inspection, one group of children were outside playing in one of the lower playgrounds, while the second group were already inside playing. The educator of the inside group informed me that they were outside earlier in the morning. The group of inside children were observed playing in the ball pit and reading books in the cozy corner.

When children came in from outside, educators were observed ensuring all children washed their hands for lunch. Today, Go-Go families were provided the opportunity to pre-order hot lunch for their children, today's hot lunch was chicken fingers and fries.

Not all preschool children nap during nap time. In the larger room, children who do not nap were provided with the opportunity to play quiet tabletop toys on carpets throughout the room, children appeared to enjoy having one of their educators' read books that they chose to them. The educator in this room also set up a painting activity for the children to participate in should they wish to. The educator in the back room was observed having the children assist her in getting the water table ready for them to play in.

Children were excited to inform me that they were in the process of decorating their classroom for Halloween. Observed handprint spiders hanging from one of their classroom boards, as well as a pumpkin for exploration and discovery purposes.
