General Comments
<p>All children were inside during today's monitoring inspection, as it was quite cold and windy outside this morning.</p> <p>In the first classroom, educators were observed setting up a painting activity for the children to do. Children were excitedly waiting for the large garbage bags to be cut and tapped to the tables so they could paint using trucks, cars, trains, anything that had wheels. Observed the children excitedly running their vehicles through the paint and then on their own papers. Other children were also observed reading books, and playing in the dinosaur, dirt, and construction vehicle sensory bin.</p> <p>Children in the small classroom were just finishing up snack, there were play invitations set up at a couple of tables, but what the children were really interested in were the new toys that were just brought into the classroom! Educator did a great job at ensuring children understood that they had to take turns with the new toys. Observed the educator sitting down and counting with the children, when they all got to 30 together, it was time of the next friend's turn. Children in this classroom were also observed playing restaurant/store together, along with one of their educators.</p> <p>Because both groups were unable to go play outside today due to the weather, they both played active games with the children. The first classroom was observed building an obstacle course for the children to go through while there was music playing. They ended up doing two different obstacle courses. The second group was observed to be playing "the floor is lava", and then "hot potato". There were lots of laughs and giggles that were heard coming from both classrooms during these active games.</p>

General Comments

All educators in both rooms were observed interacting be being attentive to children's needs throughout the entire inspection.

All children's blankets are being stored separately in their own basket.
