	While observing children play outdoors, licensing staff noted two safety hazards on the small playground that was not being used by the children on the day of the inspection. The first hazard was a broken "Connect Four" game that was stuck in the ice/snow, The legs of the game had broken away from the rest of the game and was sharp to the touch.						
	The second hazard was a small metal table stand, which was missing the tabletop, that was also stuck in the snow/ice.						
When this was brought to the attention of the Onsite Manager, the hazards were corrected while licensing staff was still onsite.

Comments:	mments: While observing the children playing outside in the outdoor play environment, licensing staff noted that the children had some play materials but did not have a variety and sufficient quantity of play materials to engage with. Please ensure additional play materials are added to the outdoor playground for the children to play with.						
General Comments							

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the annual license renewal inspection. When licensing staff arrived at the facility, one group of children were engaging in free play activities and the other group of children were having their morning snack.

During the inspection, licensing staff observed both groups of children go outside to play in the outdoor play environment. While outside, some children were on the stationary equipment, while others were engaged in dramatic play in the wooden playhouse. Some other children were very interested in watching the bus driver clear the melting ice/snow off the roof.

General Comments

The educators were observed interacting with children at their level and were using positive child guidance strategies when challenging behaviours occurred throughout the inspection.

The indoor play environment was very clean and organized and had distinct play centres set up for the children to play with.

The staff files and children's profiles were complete with all the required information.
