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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the facility to conduct an annual renewal inspection.</p> <p>At the time of arrival, both groups were off-site on a field trip via the Go-Go bus to attend a scholastic book fair. The children returned to the facility at approximately 10:45 a.m. Upon arrival, they entered the building and independently prepared for outdoor play by putting on their winter clothing, with the help of educators when needed. Educators supported the children by ensuring they were appropriately dressed before transitioning outside. Children were observed engaging in conversations about the books they had selected during the book fair.</p> <p>Outdoors, children participated in a variety of activities, including playing hide-and-seek with an educator, using play structures, and engaging with materials such as toy cars, shovels, balls, and trucks. One group was observed having a snack outside at picnic tables. The educator indicated that this adjustment was made in response to the children expressing hunger during the bus ride, demonstrating responsiveness to children's needs and flexibility in the daily schedule.</p> <p>Children remained outdoors for approximately one hour before transitioning back inside for lunch. Upon re-entry, they stored their belongings and sat on the mat while waiting for the group to gather. Handwashing routines were followed prior to eating. Children then sat at the tables and ate lunches brought from home.</p> <p>Following lunch, one group transitioned to a rest period, while the other group engaged in quiet activities. These included playing with connecting blocks, drawing, exploring books, and using a light table with various materials. Some children were also observed playing with handmade Indigenous dolls created by an educator, with one child sharing that the educator had made dolls for everyone to bring home as well. Later in the afternoon, an educator facilitated a measuring activity where children stood against a wall to have their height recorded.</p> <p>Licensing staff also observed individualized binders containing documentation of children's learning experiences throughout the year. Learning stories were also posted throughout the environment. Throughout the inspection, positive child guidance strategies were consistently observed. Monthly fire evacuation drills are conducted.</p>
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General Comments

Child and staff files were reviewed and verified.

There are currently no after school children enrolled on this license.

Licensing staff recommends the program for renewal.
