General Comments						
Preschool children were eating snack when I arrived for today's monitoring inspection. Parents/guardians provide children's snacks and lunch by use of lunchboxes with ice packs in them should food be required to be kept cold.						
After snack, one group of preschool children were observed free playing around the room, some activities they were observed partaking in were wooden blocks in the shape of animals, colouring and playing with shape magnets. The second group of children were observed listening to their educator read a story to them, then playing with foam blocks and large Lego. When both groups of children had time to play freely, they cleaned up their classroom and went to play outside.						
Educators were observed helping children apply sunscreen while outside.						
School aged children were outside in the fenced-in area when I arrived this morning, they were observed applying sunscreen and getting ready to go for a walk to play at the Park Street school's playground.						
All stationary equipment was observed to be surrounded by protective surfacing (pea gravel) at time of inspection.						

Children were observed playing ball hockey while outside. It is recommended that some sort of bottom border be added to the fence facing the parking lot to prevent the ball from going under the fence and into the parking lot, as the ball was observed going under the fence on several occasions and an educator had to go get it.
