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General Comments Renewal Inspection: A renewal inspection was conducted during the afternoon hours. The school-age children were observed in the outdoor environment. Outdoors, the educators were observed extending learning opportunities by bringing indoor materials outside. Children participated in activities such as coloring, using playground equipment, playing soccer, and having snack. The indoor environment was set up with a wide range of materials for the children to explore. Well-defined learning interest centers were in place, with materials organized on low, open shelves. Documentation was displayed within the classroom and maintained in a documentation binder. The documentation was current and accurately reflected the children's ongoing learning and play experiences. The educators shared that they are currently exploring Time Travel and have been revisiting past play experiences that children previously enjoyed, such as making slime, engaging in trivia, and exploring "ferry goblins." The following records were reviewed: incident logs, fire drills, monthly review and maintenance plans for all stationary equipment, and daily attendance records. All staff files were reviewed, and a random sample of children's files was also completed. The Inspector discussed with the Childcare Manager the importance of ensuring the playground is raked daily due to it being shared with the school. It was noted that areas under the monkey bars, slides, and swings were depleted and required raking. The Inspector also reviewed proper storage procedures for ongoing medication records, potential illness forms, and reportable incident forms within children's files. The Quality Assurance Monitor will follow up on this during the next monitoring inspection. The facility is recommended for licensing pending Fire's recommendation.
