General Comments

School aged children were not present at time of visit as they were still in school.

Educator informed me that morning drop off is normally done outside so the children can play outside before it gets too hot (depending on the weather). Children were outside for 2 hours this morning before coming in to have snack.

Once snack had finished, the educator ensured all children properly washed their hands. Once they had all washed up, they were able to free play around the room while she cleaned the tables and swept the floor. Even though she was cleaning up, the educator was always attentive to the children. Should the children need her, she would ensure to put her cleaning product/broom away properly and go right to them.

The educator set out two play invitations at tables for the children to partake in should they chose. At one table she had set out tin foil, paint, and Q-tips for the children to paint with, and at the second table she set out blocks with a sign asking the children if they could build sandcastle. Children appeared to really enjoy both activities, the painting activity started out with the children using Q-tips to paint with but ended with all the children painting their hands and putting their handprints on their tin foil. At the "sandcastle" table, children were observed building castles, school buses, buses, houses, and staircases. Children had the choice to take part in these activities, the ones who were not interested were able to play with other materials around the classroom.

Children artwork is displayed around the classroom. I observed their masterpiece paintings of a tree, entitled "can you paint a tree" and "leaf painting".

Educator was observed ensuring she got down to the children's level anytime they were speaking to her (and vise versa). She was observed always providing the children choices, asking if they needed help, all while promoting independence in the classroom.
