General Comments

Preschool program is now operating at this licensed location.

The school aged children were divided into two groups when I arrived for today's monitoring inspection. One group was outside playing in the outside play space that has the play climbers, these children were observed playing on both play structures, on a teeter totter, with hula-hoops and digging in the rocks. The group that was inside was observed doing crafts and playing with Lego. After a period of time, the two groups switched locations.

When the second school aged group came inside, they were observed playing group games, such as "the floor is lava" and "graveyard".

The preschool group is now located in the back room of the building. The preschool children were observed playing outside in the fenced in wooded area play space. These children were observed playing on plasma cars, exploring the "woods", and drawing with chalk. The educator of this group was observed sitting and drawing with the children at time of visit.

The facility's indoor environments offer a very clean and bright welcoming atmospheres for the children to thrive in. Both school age and preschool classrooms have an abundance of learning materials that meet the interests of the children. Both rooms are set up in a way that promote independence by arranging all play material on low shelves so that children can have the choice to pick their own toys.

Observed an abundance of positive child guidance during today's visit. All educators ensured they got down to the children's level when speaking with them.
