### General Comments

Monitoring visit was done with the preschool children only today as the school aged children were still in school.

Children were making their way outside when I arrived for today's visit. They were observed partaking in many different activities outside such as digging in the rocks, on the slide structure, playing tag with an educator, filling up a wagon with rocks, making soup/recipes, and climbing on the climbing structure.

Children were observed having the opportunity to partake in risky play while outside, learning to do different tricks on the climbing structure. Educators were observed staying very close to the children on the climbing structure in order to be able to provide quick assistance if needed. Educators were also observe using many words of encouragement to the children at this time.

The sunshade and umbrellas in the outside play space have been set up for the hot summer months.

Educators were observed being respectful to children's play throughout the whole visit as they were observed asking the children's permission if they could join in their play before joining in.

After lunch, one educator was observed reading a book to the children while the other cleaned up the tables and floor. Educator who was reading the story was observed asking questions and interacting with the children throughout the story to keep them engaged. The children who were being read to were observed to be very interested and enjoying the book, as there were many giggles and cheers heard while they were being read to. Children who were no longer interested in the book were able to help clean the tables or play freely around the room.

A reminder to ensure all children wash their hands upon entering the facility from playing outside, especially before snack/lunch time.
