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| <p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Upon licensing staff arrival, children were engaged in outdoor play. Children were participating in a variety of activities, including playing in the play kitchen, playing soccer, and exploring a sensory bin that had been prepared by the educators. Crafts were also set up on the picnic table as an invitation to play. Educators were observed actively playing and engaging with the children throughout the outdoor play period, giving positive feedback to their craft creations and how far they can kick a ball.</p> <p>The groups then transitioned indoors. One group sat down together to read a book, while the other group engaged in free play with building blocks, toy cars, and other loose parts. Both groups later transitioned to playing with play dough, with a variety of accessories and tools provided by the educators to support the children's creativity.</p> <p>An activity focused on recycling was also offered as part of the "Recycling Week" theme. During the observed activity, children painted recycled materials. The educator encouraged their participation by asking the children which colors of paint they wanted to use. The children worked together as a group to paint the recycled materials.</p> <p>Prior to the next transition, the educators provided the children with a ten-minute warning to allow them time to prepare for cleanup. The children then participated together in songs, including a song about the letters of the alphabet and the "Hop, Bunny" song. The educator was interactive with the children and giving words of encouragement while learning the alphabet. The children then cleaned their hands and prepared for lunch.</p> <p>The required professional learning hours have been completed. Learning stories are displayed on the walls. Staff and children's files were also complete. Only positive child guidance was observed throughout the visit.</p> <p>Licensing staff recommends the program for renewal.</p> |
