| Comments: The wooden fence that have been put into the licensed space are rough and has splintered wood on it. The openings between the wood must not allow entry for a child's hands or feet. Some of the space between the wood may allow small body parts to get stuck. The brackets at the bottom of the fencing are sharp, there are screws protruding. The indoor fencing must be removed. Also, there is a lot of evident clutter and a lack of organization. Materials are being piled up on the shelving.. | | | |
