| Comments: Licensing staff spoke to an educator about watching the level and tones of their voice when they are speaking to the children. Children also cannot be excluded from a group or activity and reminded who they need to apologize to. Licensing staff spoke to the educators and to the administrator and interactions with the children were much more positive for the rest of the day. |            |                      |                |

| General Comments  |
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| <p>Purposefully planned documentation was not evident in most classrooms at the time of my visit. Some classrooms are using programming books or weekly lesson plans but regulation states each educator must demonstrate that planning is a process that involves engaging the children and reflecting on the children's interests, passions, strengths and abilities. The pre-planned program should be a process that shows how the activities and materials used for the children is based off their interests and ideas such as webbing or journaling.</p> <p>There needs to be more defined learning centres in each of the classrooms with a variety of materials to promote learning. Please reference the New Brunswick Curriculum Frame work to help with this. Many of the areas have a large amount of clutter and it needs to be reduced and cleaned up as discussed. This includes the larger bathroom which is being used as a storage area.</p> <p>Most of the educators have completed their professional learning hours; some will need to have a plan to complete them by the end of January.</p> <p>As the weather is changing and the ground is freezing it is difficult to determine if there is enough surfacing around the play structure. Please ensure it meets regulation in the spring. Licensing staff also discussed the requirement of more materials for learning centres in the outdoor play area. The outdoor play area should be an extension of the indoor play area.</p> <p>Licensing staff observed the flexibility of the educators when children do not sleep at nap time. The children are given activities to do and the educators were observed interacting with these children.</p> <p>Licensing staff will forward the current requirements for the first aid check lists as set by Worksafe N.B.</p> <p>The filing system was easily verified by licensing staff. It is organized and complete.</p> |
