Upon arrival, it was visibly noticeable that more shelving was purchased and more materials were available to the children. This was evident in all of the preschool classroom's. The Operator was also putting cubbies together for the children to store personal belongings.

A pre-planned program was evident in most of the rooms and the educators have embraced the idea of building a program that is built on the children's interests. The 4 year old educator will require more support in this area. All activities should be child led.

Please continue to monitor and reduce clutter within the facility. The facility should appear organized and clean.
